**Proposed Plan for Installation Restoration Site 34
Former Naval Air Station Alameda**

The Department of the Navy (DON), in coordination with state and federal environmental regulatory agencies, requests the public to comment on the Proposed Plan to address contamination at Installation Restoration (IR) Site 34 at the former Naval Air Station Alameda (Alameda Point). Alameda Point is located on the western tip of Alameda Island, on the eastern side of San Francisco Bay, California, and was used to provide facilities and support for fleet aviation and Naval activities. IR Site 34 is located in the north-central portion of Alameda Point, adjacent to the Oakland Inner Harbor. The Proposed Plan presents a summary of investigations performed at IR Site 34 and remedial alternatives to address surface and subsurface soil contamination due to specific chemicals of concern, which pose unacceptable risks to human health and wildlife. The DON's preferred remedial alternative involves the excavation and disposal of contaminated soils, which would be protective of the human health and the environment for the current land use and all potential land uses.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

DON invites interested members of the public to review and comment on the IR Site 34 Proposed Plan during a 30-day Public Comment Period, from July 15 through August 13, 2010. Public comments must be submitted in writing and be postmarked or e-mailed no later than August 13, 2010. In addition, members of the public are invited to attend the Public Meeting on Tuesday, July 27, 2010 at the Alameda Public Library, 1550 Oak Street, Alameda, California 94501, at 6:30 pm. Verbal and written public comments on the Proposed Plan will be accepted at this meeting.
