Public Meeting for Removal Action at Installation Restoration Program Site 11 (Disposal Pits) NASA Crows Landing Flight Facility (Former Naval Auxiliary Landing Field, Crows Landing) Stanislaus County, CA

The Navy will be conducting a public meeting to present an overview of a removal action at the former Naval Auxiliary Landing Field, Crows Landing in Stanislaus County, California.

The removal action will be implemented at a former refuse disposal site, Installation Restoration Program (IRP) Site 11, located on the north end of the two existing runways within the facility. This removal action is intended to address the potential risks posed by the buried waste, debris, and munitions scrap at the site. The proposed removal action includes excavation and off-site disposal of the buried waste, debris, and munitions scrap. Detailed descriptions of the removal action and another potential alternative (which allows the buried waste to remain in place) are presented in the Draft Final Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis (EE/CA) dated January 2005.

The Draft Final EE/CA and other documents pertaining to the removal action are available for public inspection in the Navy's Comprehensive Environmental Response Compensation and Liability Act Administrative Record Files and the information repository at the Stanislaus County Library, Patterson Branch on 46 North Salado, Patterson, California (Telephone: 209 892-6473). The Navy invites the community to submit comments on the Draft Final EE/CA. The Draft Final EE/CA will be available for public review until February 14, 2005. The Draft Final EE/CA will be finalized following the receipt and incorporation of public comments.
