The U.S. Navy, in coordination with state and federal environmental regulatory agencies, is announcing the public availability of the Action Memorandum (AM) for a Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) time critical removal action at the Construction Equipment Department (CED) Area, NCBC Davisville, North Kingstown, Rhode Island. The removal action was for the excavation and proper disposal of buried drums that were discovered during site development related activities. The drums were located on the western portion of Parcel 7 and north of Davisville Road. The AM documents the actions taken, including removal and off-site disposal of the buried drums and debris, soil testing, monitoring well installation, and ground water sampling. In accordance with this AM, the buried drums and debris have been removed. The AM is being made available to the public for review.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

The AM and Administrative Record file are available for public review and the Navy will accept comments during the 30-day public comment period held from January 9, 2014 through February 8, 2014. Public comments must be submitted in writing and postmarked or emailed no later than February 8, 2014.
