Dear Restoration Advisory Board Member:

Reference (a) proposed adjournment of the Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) at the Charleston Naval Complex (CNC) due to declining community interest. The Department of the Navy has not received any comments opposing the RAB disestablishment. As such, the CNC RAB is hereby formally adjourned.

We sincerely thank you for your participation in the RAB. During its fifteen-year existence, the RAB served as a focal point for the exchange of information between the CNC and the community regarding environmental restoration activities. Your efforts facilitated transfer of all 2,922 acres of the former Navy property to other federal agencies and to the community. Additionally, your participation helped the Navy achieve the significant milestone of remedies in place at all cleanup sites aboard the CNC. Furthermore, your assistance allowed attainment of 300 No Further Action and 40 Land Use Control determinations at environmental remediation sites throughout the Complex.
