



**PUBLIC NOTICE
BASE-WIDE FIVE-YEAR REVIEW
INSTALLATION RESTORATION SITES
1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6A, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, and 14
FORMER LONG BEACH NAVAL COMPLEX, LONG BEACH, CA**

The Department of the Navy (Navy) is currently conducting a Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) Five-Year Review at the Former Long Beach Naval Complex (LBNC), Long Beach, California. The Former LBNC includes the Former Long Beach Naval Station and the Former Long Beach Naval Shipyard, which are located on Terminal Island between the City of Long Beach and the San Pedro District of the City of Los Angeles. The Navy is conducting the Five-Year Review in accordance with the requirements of CERCLA Section 121(c). The purpose of this Five-Year Review is to determine whether the remedies selected in Records of Decision (RODs) for Installation Restoration (IR) Sites 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6A, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, and 13; and the institutional controls (ICs) identified in the Land Use Control Remedial Design document for IR Site 14 remain protective of human health and the environment.

The following bullets summarize the selected cleanup remedies currently in place for the sites to be evaluated in this Five-Year Review:

- The selected remedy for IR Sites 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6A, 8, 9, 10, 11, 13 and 14 consists of ICs.
- The selected remedy for IR Site 12, consists of ICs and maintenance of cover.

The Navy plans to issue a Draft Five-Year Review Report of findings to the California Department of Toxics Substances Control and to the Santa Ana Regional Water Quality Control Board for review; a final report will be issued in October 2019. The Navy will issue another Public Notice announcing the completion of the Five-Year Review.
