FINAL GROUNDWATER RECORD OF DECISION
IRP SITES 1 AND 2
FORMER MARINE CORPS AIR STATION,
ORANGE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA



The Final Groundwater Record of Decision (ROD) for Installation Restoration Program (IRP) Sites 1 and 2 at Former MCAS El Toro documents the remedies selected for groundwater at these Sites. The remedy for perchlorate-impacted groundwater at Site 1 is in-situ bioremediation (ISB), monitoring, and institutional controls (ICs). The remedy for volatile organic compound (VOC)-impacted groundwater at Site 2 is monitored natural attenuation (MNA) and ICs. Periodic reviews will be conducted to ensure that the remedies remain protective of human health and the environment.

Impacted soil at IRP Site 1 will be addressed in a separate ROD to be issued at a later date. The final remedial action for soil at IRP Site 2, a landfill cap, was completed in February 2008.

The Final Groundwater ROD for IRP Sites 1 and 2 is available for public review at the locations presented below.
