

Attached please find the uniform underground storage tank (UST) closure letter and the site closure summary forms for the above referenced USTs. This letter documents that, based on available information, no further action (NFA) related to the above mentioned underground storage tank releases is required.

The NFA status applies only to releases of petroleum from fuel USTs at the above referenced sites. For those sites where groundwater is polluted by non-petroleum related chemicals or where other sources of petroleum pollution exist (fuel lines, spills, and above ground tanks), this determination is applicable only to soil and groundwater impacts associated with these UST

releases. The Regional Water Quality Control Board shall be notified with any changes of future land use.

The existing monitoring wells that will no longer be used should be properly destroyed pursuant to the Santa Clara County monitoring well abandonment guidelines. For more information regarding these guidelines, please contact the Santa Clara County Environmental Health Services at (408) 299-6930.




