**Subject: No Further Action Concurrence on Appendix E of the Draft Final Base Wide Petroleum Site Evaluation Methodology Technical Memorandum, Site 19, Moffett Federal Air Field, Moffett Field, California and Draft Final Addendum to Appendix E, Site 19 Petroleum Evaluation**

Dear Mr. Tamayo:

The San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board staff has reviewed the Tetra Tech EM Inc. (TtEMI), report entitled: "Draft Final Appendix E, Site 19 Petroleum Evaluation, Basewide Petroleum Site Evaluation Methodology Technical Memorandum, Moffett Federal Air Field, Moffett Field, California" dated December 11, 2000 and the Foster Wheeler Environmental Corporation report titled "Draft Final Addendum to Appendix E, Site 19 Petroleum Evaluation", dated July 16, 2003.

Site 19 consists of four underground storage tanks (USTs). However, only USTs 14 and 53 are subject to petroleum site closure and evaluation requirements, since the other two tanks held non-petroleum substances. The Regional Board closed UST 14 and UST 53 on August 8, 2002, and February 20, 2004, respectively. With the condition that all information presented to the Board in the above reference reports are representative of site conditions, no further action with respect to Site 19 petroleum evaluation is required.
