Historic Preservation Group			
California Historic Civil Engineering Landmark Plaque, located on the outside wall at the east/northern side. Provide to NASA Historic Preservation Officer (HPO).		1	
Drawing file cabinets (3 sections) located in Ops Line Room, West side of hangar. Provide to NASA HPO.		2	Will collect up to 20 representative samples of various drawers inside and outside. Drawings will have representative samples collected, some may be saved, others may have to be disposed.
Special hangar corrugated windows with wire mesh insert. Located throughout the hangar side and end walls. Provide three panels to Moffett Historical Society and remaining (as many as possible) to NASA HPO.		3	Includes salvage of 3 panels only. Remaining panels are included in the contract option.
Two Sections of original exterior metal hangar siding located at the upper curve section. Remove 4 ft x 3 ft. sections of original metal hangar siding and preserve for Moffett Historical Society and NASA HPO.		4	Panels will be cut to the requested 4' length. Panels will be wrapped in 6 mil poly for turnover to NASA. The panels cannot be decontaminated since the internal structure (layers) of the panel contain contaminants that cannot be removed. Therefore, the panels will need to be managed by NASA as hazardous materials.

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Explosion proof light fixtures (approximately 8 ea.) mounted 7 ft. from floor and located in front of columns within the hangar. Provide three panels to Moffett Historical Society and remaining to NASA HPO.		5	Light fixtures may contain asbestos, and they have not been sampled or characterized yet.
Large wrench (3 ft. long); located by column 14. Provide to NASA HPO.		6	
Pair of large wood doors at entry to Cell Room (Cork Room – North end) for Moffett Historical Society.		7	
Traveling rack with gear, chain and hooks, Save 10 to 15 foot of assembly. Located inside the Cork Room for Moffett Historical Society.		8	
Elevator cab. Located on West side of hangar behind locked chain link fence for Moffett Historical Society.		9	Elevator cab will be decontaminated and transported to N207 High Bay. Motors and hoists will not be salvaged.
Cork wall; remove a 6 ft x 8 ft section of cork from the cell room (cork room) Located on the upper level, (east side) for Moffett Historical Society.		10	Cork wall may contain asbestos, and has not been sampled or characterized yet. If cork contains asbestos, the wall will be wrapped in polyethylene and labeled appropriately as asbestos-containing material.
Man cranes for Moffett Historical Society.		11	The man cranes will be decontaminated and transported to N207 High Bay.

Clearance samples will be collected to verify the residual contamination, but the painting may not ever come clean as the paint is rough. It may need to be re-framed and enclosed under glass.
One pair of yellow chocks (for securing aircraft). Outside simulator bldg.		2	
Blimp gondola skeleton, 2 pieces. Located outside simulator bldg.		3	
Rubber mats with writing, 3 each. Located outside simulator bldg near bell.		4	
USCG bell in frame. Located outside simulator bldg.		5	
Eagles & Anchor Club sign. Inside simulator bldg (room 512).		6	
Extension cable. Located inside simulator bldg. (room 512).		7	
Display cases. Inside simulator bldg. (room 512).		8	
Public Works Officer Plaque.		9	
Air Show posters 2001 / 2002.		10	Includes collection of several representative samples of interior stacked items. Depending on sampling results, as many items will be cleared as possible.

Two large wall signs: "Commanding Officer, NAS Moffett Field" & "Operations" (a large blue naval aviation wing signs). Located on wall facing interior of the hangar directly across from the entry point into the hangar. One sign is 8 ft above floor level and the large "Operations" sign is 20 ft above floor.		15
