History

- **Evolution of issue** (Navy found irregular soil data; Tetra Tech reported scanning issues; Navy found additional issues; Former Tetra Tech employee claims)
- **In 2016 Navy suspended property transfer and initiated an extensive data analysis**
- **In Nov 2017 Navy concluded and EPA reinforced that the Tetra Tech data was not reliable for making decisions**
- **Parcel A was previously delisted and transferred in 2004**

Plan Forward

- **Support Parcel A evaluation**
- **Parcel G work plan released for regulatory and public review on June 15th, comment period concludes on August 14th**
- **Address comments and issue Draft Final work plan**
- **Contract actions underway to facilitate implementation, anticipate being in the field before the end of the year**
- **Navy hired independent 3rd party oversight**
- **Once progress is made on Parcel G, can proceed with other parcels**

Navy Commitment

- **Nearly \$1B invested in HPNS cleanup program and will continue to dedicate resources until all successfully completed**
- **Navy pursuing Contractual Actions**
- **Navy supporting Multiple Legal Actions**
- **Incredibly complex issue, while time is of the essence, primary focus is ensuring safe clean up and transfer**
