## Asbestos Abatement, Building Demolition, and Excavation IR Site 12: Residential Area, Former Naval Station Treasure Island

**Updated Work Will Be Performed Between  
Monday, October 15, 2018 – Friday, June 21, 2019  
7:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday - Friday, excluding holidays**

The Navy's contractor, Gilbane, will be working in the residential area at the northern end of the Former Naval Station Treasure Island (TI).

<b>WHY IS WORK BEING DONE?</b>	The Navy is demolishing unoccupied buildings and excavating and disposing of contaminated soil to ensure chemical cleanup of Installation Restoration (IR) Site 12.
<b>WHAT WILL BE DONE?</b>	Buildings 1126 Reeves Court and 1217 Mariner Drive, including foundations, will be excavated. While the work is being conducted, work areas will be created using orange cones, caution tape, and temporary fencing. Fences will be erected around impacted buildings. For your safety, please give the workers space, and do not enter these areas.
<b>WHERE WILL IT BE DONE?</b>	See the map attached to this notice for the location of buildings to be demolished and fences to be erected around the work zones.
<b>HOW WILL IT IMPACT TENANTS?</b>	<u>Heavy equipment, large trucks and field vehicles will be utilized. There will be potential noise during the demolition of foundations from equipment backup alarms, and potential traffic during the off-haul of soil and demolition debris. Trucks hauling soil and debris will be tarped and marked with a green numbered circle. Truck loading may temporarily affect parking immediately adjacent to the fenced areas.</u>
