



**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF RECORD OF  
DECISION/FINAL REMEDIAL ACTION PLAN FOR  
SITE 27, FORMER CLIPPER COVE SKEET RANGE**

**FORMER NAVAL STATION TREASURE ISLAND  
SAN FRANCISCO, CALIFORNIA**



The Department of the Navy announces the release of the Record of Decision (ROD)/Final Remedial Action Plan (RAP) for Site 27, the former Clipper Cove Skeet Range at the former Naval Station Treasure Island in San Francisco, California. Site 27 consists of 19 acres within Clipper Cove, located in the San Francisco Bay between Treasure Island and Yerba Buena Island. A portion of the Treasure Island Marina is located within Site 27. The ROD/Final RAP presents the remedy selected to address lead shot contamination in sediment resulting from historical skeet range activities that pose a risk to diving ducks that could consume the lead shot. The ROD/Final RAP was signed by the Navy, the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC), and the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board in March 2012.

The selected remedy was presented to the public for review in the Proposed Plan/Draft RAP for Site 27. The remedy includes removal of contaminated sediment at shallow depths where there is a current complete exposure pathway to diving ducks, backfilling the area to prevent future exposure, and restriction of activities that might disturb the sediment. The public was invited to comment on the Proposed Plan/Draft RAP during a 30-day comment period from June 2 to July 2, 2011, and during a public meeting on June 14, 2011. DTSC also invited the public to review and comment on the draft Negative Declaration for Site 27 pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). The remedy was selected after public comments were received and addressed.
