Former Naval Station Treasure Island Notice of Second Five-Year Review

The Department of the Navy is currently conducting the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) Five-Year Review for former Naval Station Treasure Island in San Francisco, California. The Navy is conducting the Five-Year Review in accordance with the requirements of CERCLA Section 121 (c).

The purpose of this Second Five-Year Review is to determine whether the remedies implemented in accordance with the Final Records of Decision for Installation Restoration Program Sites 6, 12, 21, 24, 27, and 30 remain protective of human health and the environment.

The Draft Five-Year Review was placed into the information repositories located at the San Francisco Public Library (100 Larkin Street, San Francisco, CA), and on Treasure Island (1 Avenue of the Palms, San Francisco, CA), on September 13, 2019, where it will be available for public review through October 13, 2019. Written comments will be received at the mailing address and email below.

The Navy will issue a public notice announcing the finalization of the Five-Year Review and submittal to the information repositories listed above. Responses to comments received on the draft will be included in the final document.
