The Department of the Navy, in coordination with state and federal environmental regulatory agencies, encourages the public to comment on the Proposed Plan for the Former Inland Burn/Railroad Sidings Excavations (FIB/RSE) site (Unexploded Ordnance [UXO] Sites 9 and 3) at the former Naval Weapons Station Seal Beach Detachment Concord (NWS Concord) in Concord, California.

The FIB/RSE site is located in the Inland Area of the former NWS Concord. The Proposed Plan presents a summary of investigations as well as the Navy's preferred remedial alternative of implementation of land use controls.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

The Navy invites interested members of the public to review and comment on the Proposed Plan during the 30-day public comment period from **June 15, 2017, through July 17, 2017**.
