The meeting will include updates and presentations with members of the RAB made up of representatives from the local community and the Navy. The Navy encourages the public to participate and keep informed about the environmental cleanup at the Former Naval Weapons Station Concord (NWS Concord) in Concord, California.

The virtual meeting will include presentations about the Navy's environmental work and reports. The presentation slides will be available for live viewing to all who use the virtual format, while the presenters will be audio only. The Navy will provide an update on the summary of 2020 field work and a 2021 look ahead at NWS Concord.
