



## NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY AND PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD



### Proposed Plan for Installation Restoration Site 22 Former Naval Weapons Station Seal Beach Detachment Concord

The Department of the Navy (DON), along with state and federal environmental regulatory agencies, encourages the public to comment on the Proposed Plan to address contamination at Installation Restoration (IR) Site 22 at the former Naval Weapons Station Seal Beach Detachment Concord (NAVWPNSTA Concord). Former NAVWPNSTA Concord was a major naval munitions transport and shipment facility located in the north-central portion of Contra Costa County, California, about 30 miles northeast of San Francisco. IR Site 22, the Main Magazine Area, is located within the southwestern portion of the base. The Proposed Plan presents a summary of investigations performed at IR Site 22 and remedial alternatives to address surface soil contamination due to arsenic and endrin. Arsenic is a component of an herbicide solution used to control weeds, and endrin is a pesticide and insecticide commonly used on crops. The DON's preferred remedial alternative is a combination of land use controls for arsenic (531 acre area) and soil excavation with offsite disposal for endrin (500 square foot area).

#### **PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD**

The DON invites interested members of the public to review and comment on the Site 22 Proposed Plan from April 1 through April 30, 2010. Public comments must be submitted in writing and postmarked or e-mailed no later than April 30, 2010.
