- Following CERCLA cleanup process
- PFAS Investigations began in 2010
 - Basewide PFAS Sampling Investigation (2016-2017) - 12 Sites Investigated
 - Basewide Preliminary Assessment (2016-2017) - 10 Additional PFAS Release Areas Identified
 - Basewide PFAS SI (2018-2019) - 18 Sites Investigated
 - Basewide PFOS and PFOA Land Use Control (2018) – Restricts use of groundwater on-base
- Off-base drinking water sampling was not conducted prior to 2020 because Navy and regulatory partners did not identify a concern for impacts to private drinking water wells based on available information
- Current data indicates
 - Numerous release areas confirmed that require additional investigation
 - Results along the perimeter of the property identified potential off-base movement of PFAS in groundwater
- Combination of monitoring well data, groundwater flow data, and proximity to potential drinking water aquifers determined five (5) off-base sampling areas
- Continue basewide investigation of all release areas (Remedial Investigation 2021)
