(Approximately 45.00 Acres)**

The Department of the Navy announces the availability for review of the Finding of Suitability to Transfer (FOST) for approximately 45.00 acres of land at the Former Naval Air Station Brunswick in Brunswick, Maine. The United States of America plans to convey Parcels EDC-40 and EDC-40A (15.52 acres) to the Midcoast Regional Redevelopment Authority and Parcels REC-10 and REC-10A (29.48 acres) to the Town of Brunswick. Parcels EDC-40 and REC-10 contain Site 12, the Explosive Ordnance Disposal Area, which has undergone extensive remediation. The FOST presents the Navy's determination that the property is environmentally suitable for transfer.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

The FOST is available for public review, and the Navy will accept comments from January 24 through February 24, 2017.
